P R E F A C E

The Central Bureau of Statistics is pleased to present to the public the fifth and last volume in this series of census publications which was conducted in the areas administered by Israel in August-September, 1967.

This volume includes completions of a few subjects which had already appeared in previous volumes and which have been compiled from the detailed data: marital status, fertility, infant mortality, emigration of sons/daughters, labour force and housing.

Information is also given on the distribution of adults enumerated in 1967, in the areas administered by Israel, by their place of residence before the 1948 war. These data are based on a 20 per cent sample enumeration of the population.

The 1967 Census in the areas administered by Israel was very valuable to the administration and research staff enabling them to obtain conclusive statistical information on the population in these areas: its size, composition, factors of its growth, labour force and housing conditions, receiving of assistance, etc.

This census serves as a base for the official statistics on the population which has been compiled since, in the administered areas.

It is my pleasant duty to express once again the Bureau's appreciation to the Israel Defence Forces Headquarters who assisted in carrying out the Census in the Administered Areas. We also express our thanks to the numerous members of the staff who planned and conducted the Census and published its results. The names of these in charge of the various activities were given in the first publication of this series.
