Has both a home-visiting and supervisory role. Proves the coordination necessary to ensure that households get a seamless service from the range of single purpose health care worker.

Provides treatment support to encourage adherence to treatment for opportunistic infections etc. Ensuring that adherence is high and that ill people are getting a reasonable standard of home care and palliation when required.

*NATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS FRAMEWORK (NQF)

Three bands of education

South Africa's National Qualifications
Framework (NQF) recognises three broad
bands of education: General Education and
Training (GET, 0-grade 9; enrollment is at
grade 0 or R which stands for reception
year; ages 7-15), Further Education and
Training (leads to "matric"; grades 10,11
and 12) and Higher Education and Training.

Hence, school life in South Africa spans 13 years or grades, from grade 0, otherwise known as grade R or "reception year", through to grade 12 or "matric" - the year of matriculation. Two levels of education are distinguished as follows:

- a) General Education and Training
 (GET) runs from grade 0 to grade 9.
 Under the South African Schools Act
 of 1996, education is compulsory for
 all South Africans from age 7 (grade
 1) to age 15, or the completion of
 grade 9. General Education and
 Training also includes Adult Basic
 Education and Training. GET
 corresponds to the first (lowest) level
 of qualification referred to as NQF1.
- b) Further Education and Training takes place from grades 10 to 12, and also
