- **Men: 48.2%**
- **Urban population: about 64 %**
- **State religion: Christianity (since 301 A.D.)**

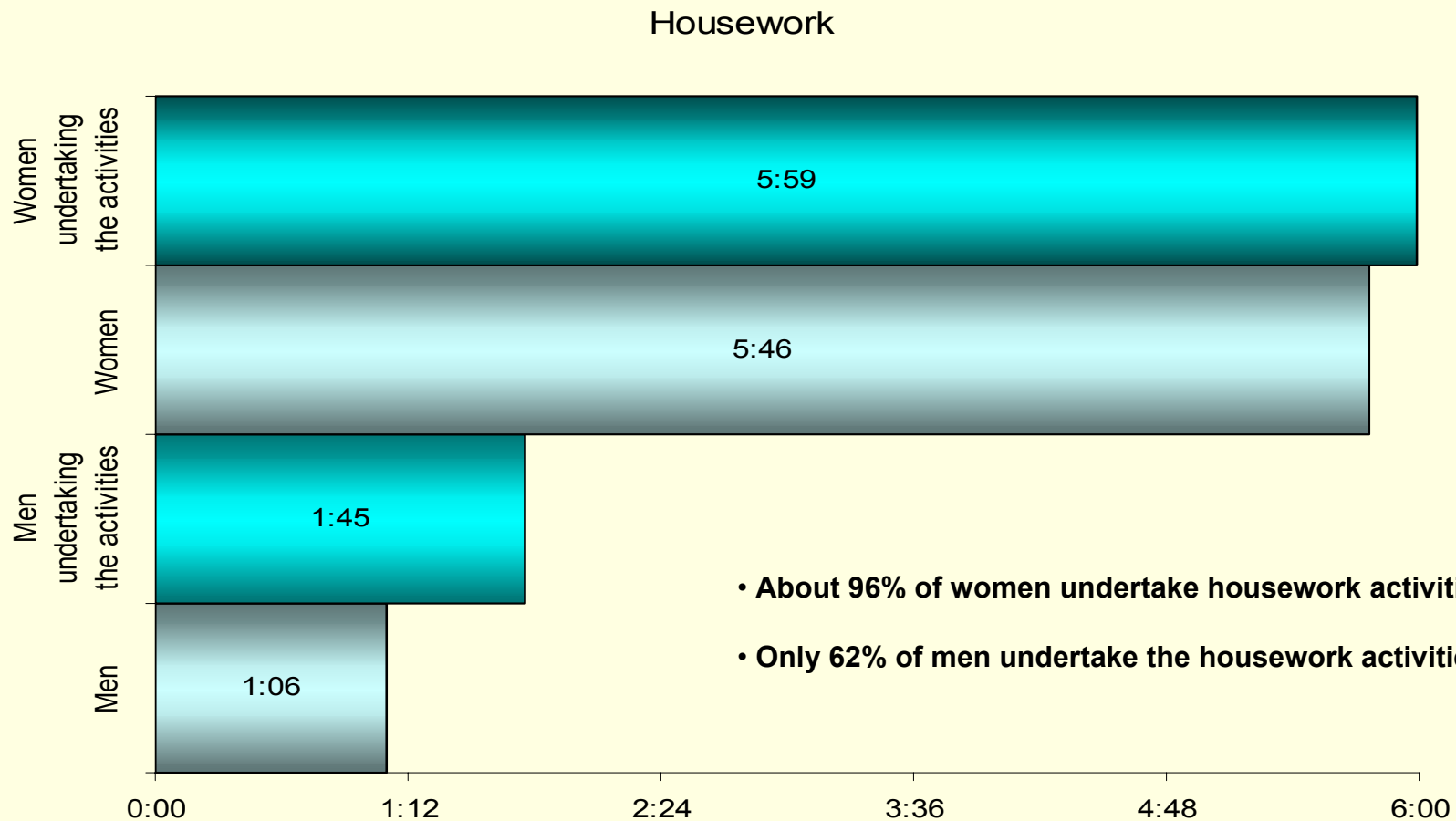

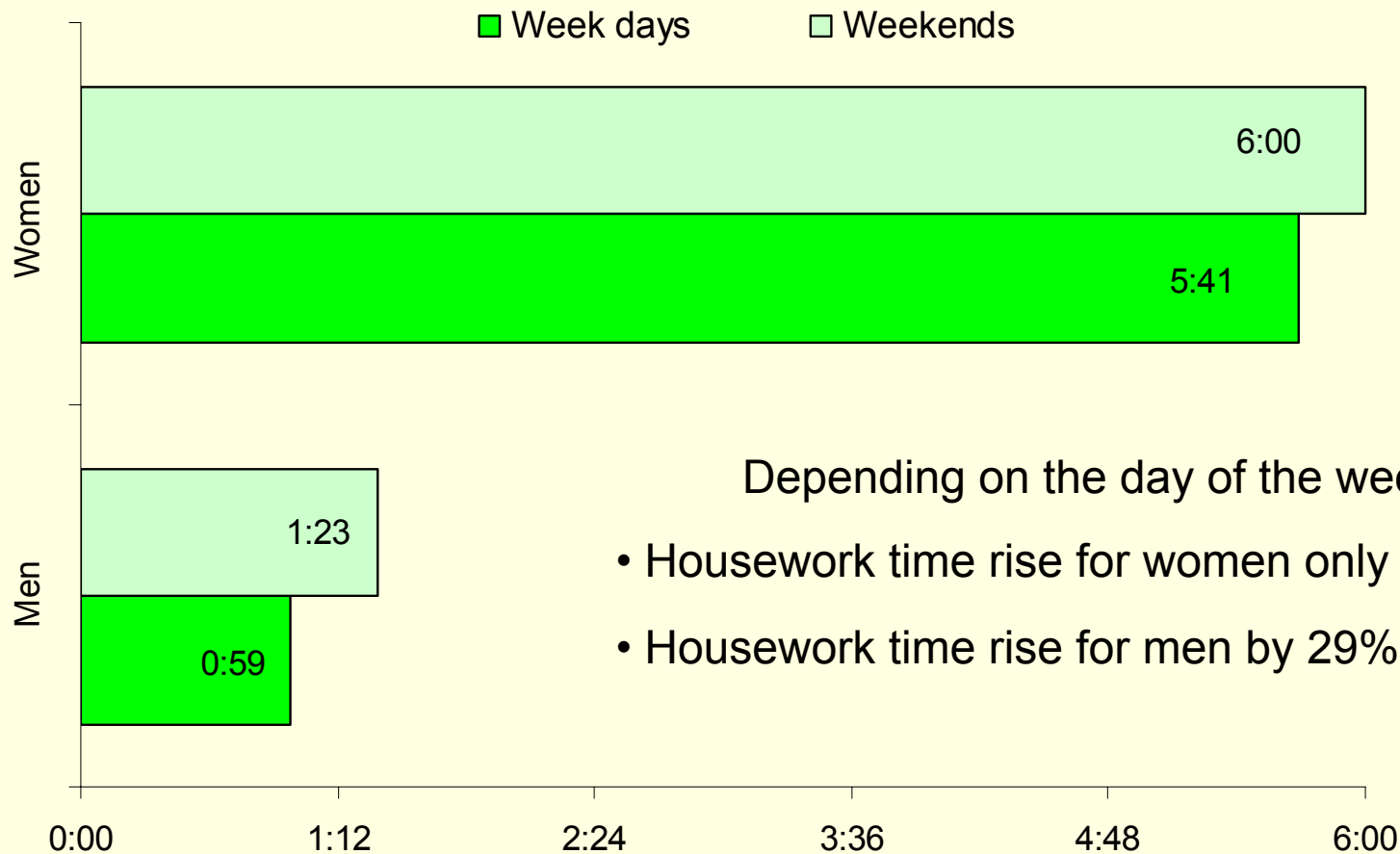
World Women Report and other International Papers

- Women spend as much time as men on paid work
- Women spend twice as much more time than men on unpaid work
- Women do far more paid and unpaid caring work than men (home and workplace)

Unpaid Work and Gender inequality in Armenia - two major differences



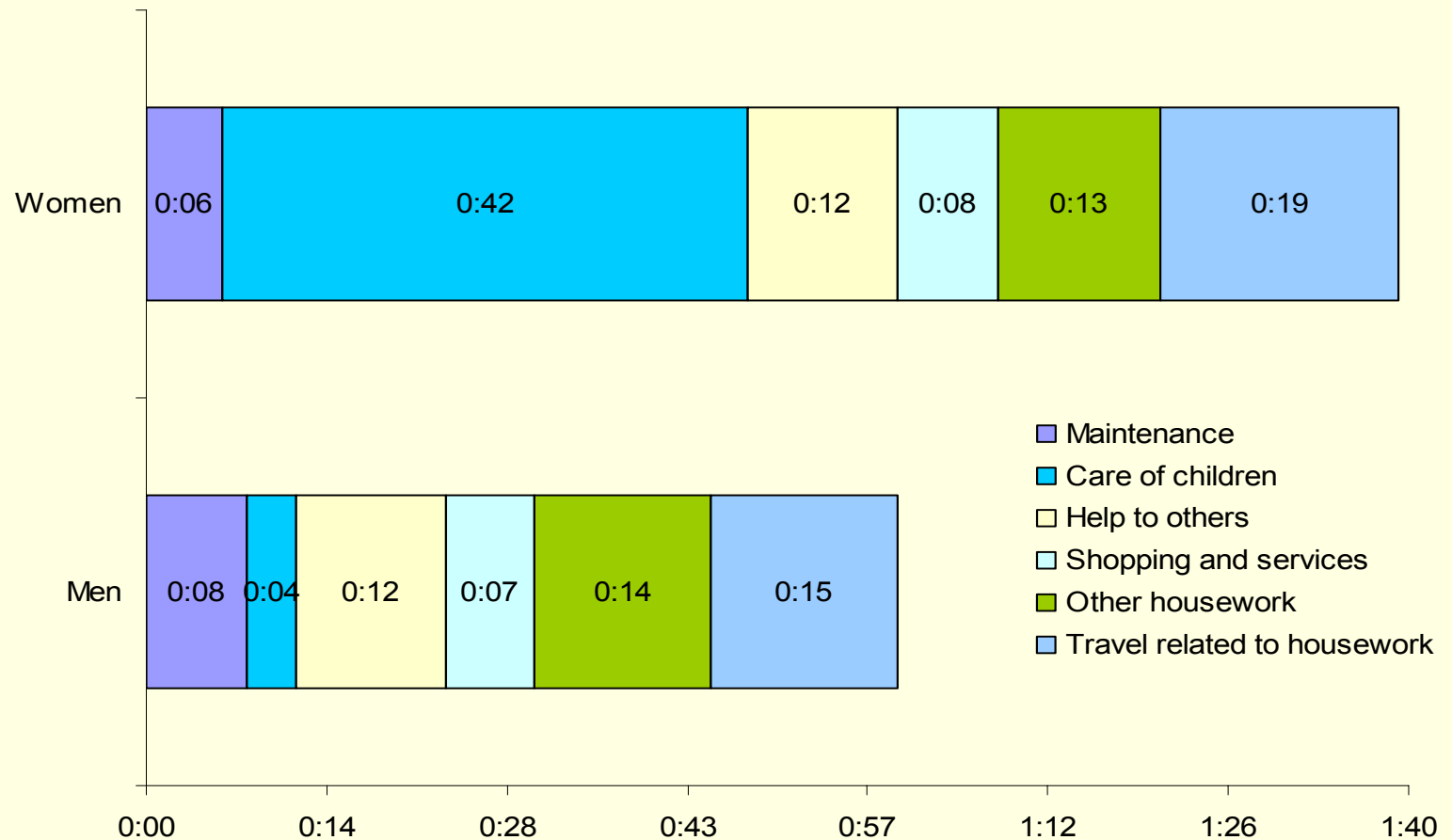
Depending on the day of the week:

- Housework time rise for men by 29%

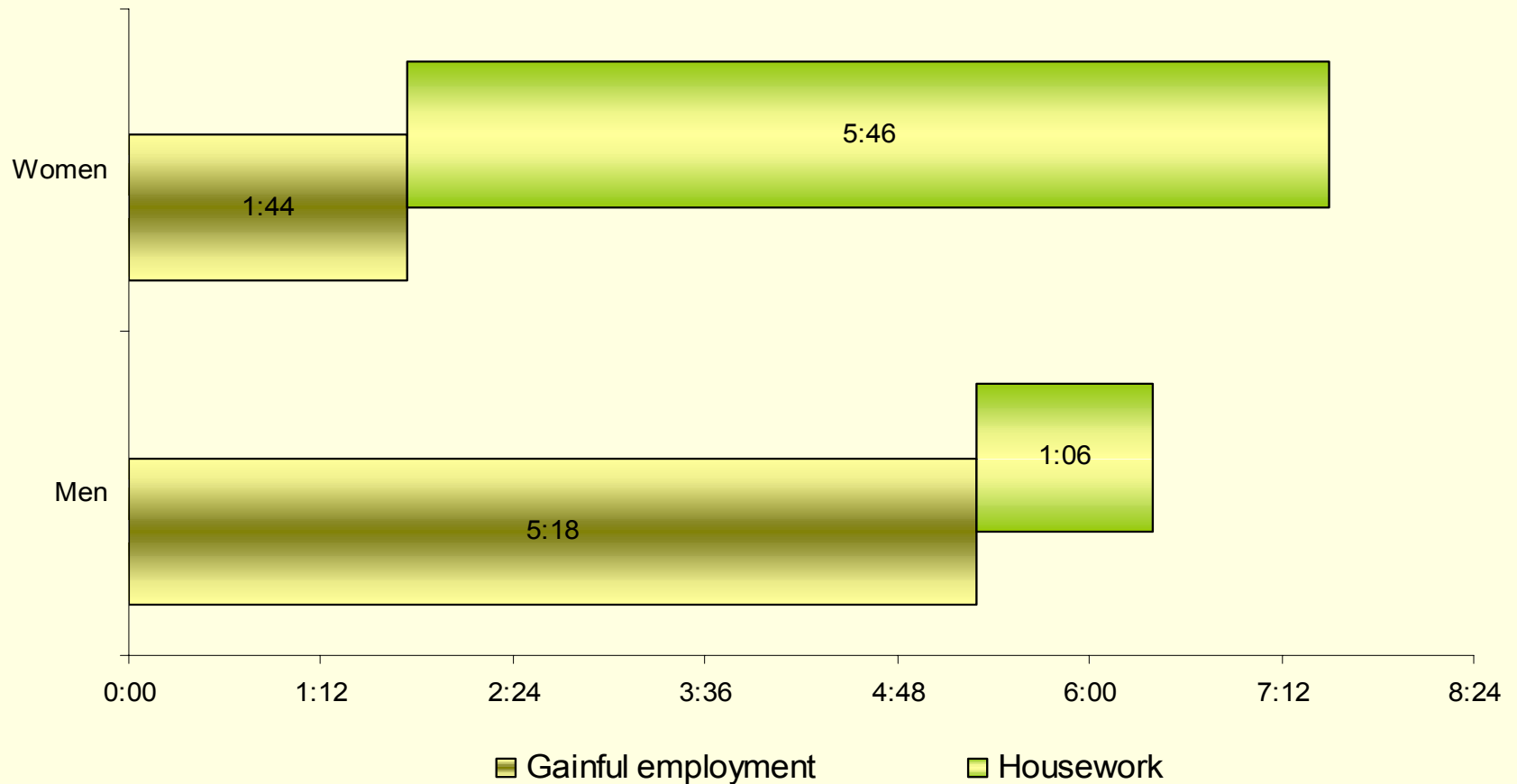

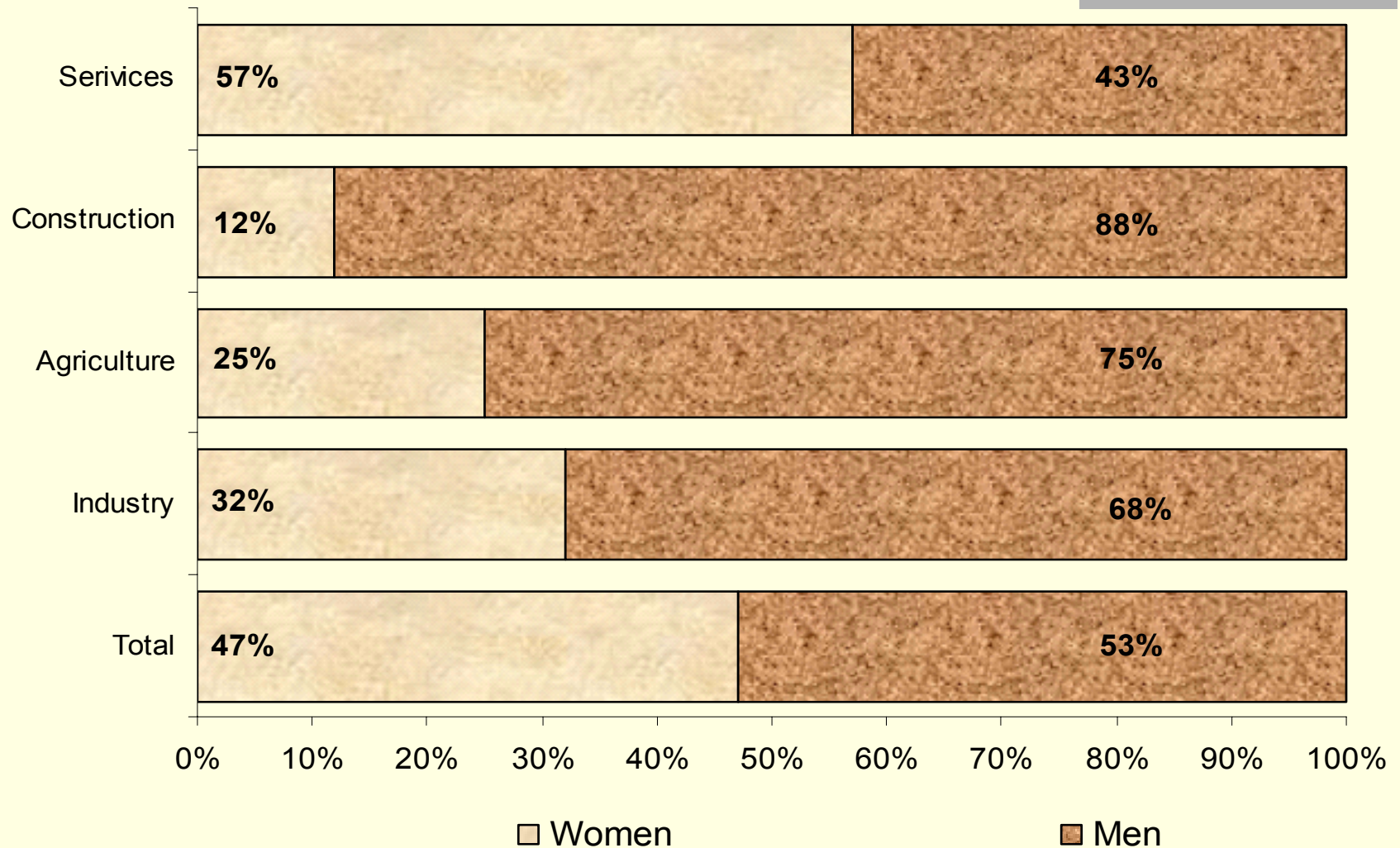

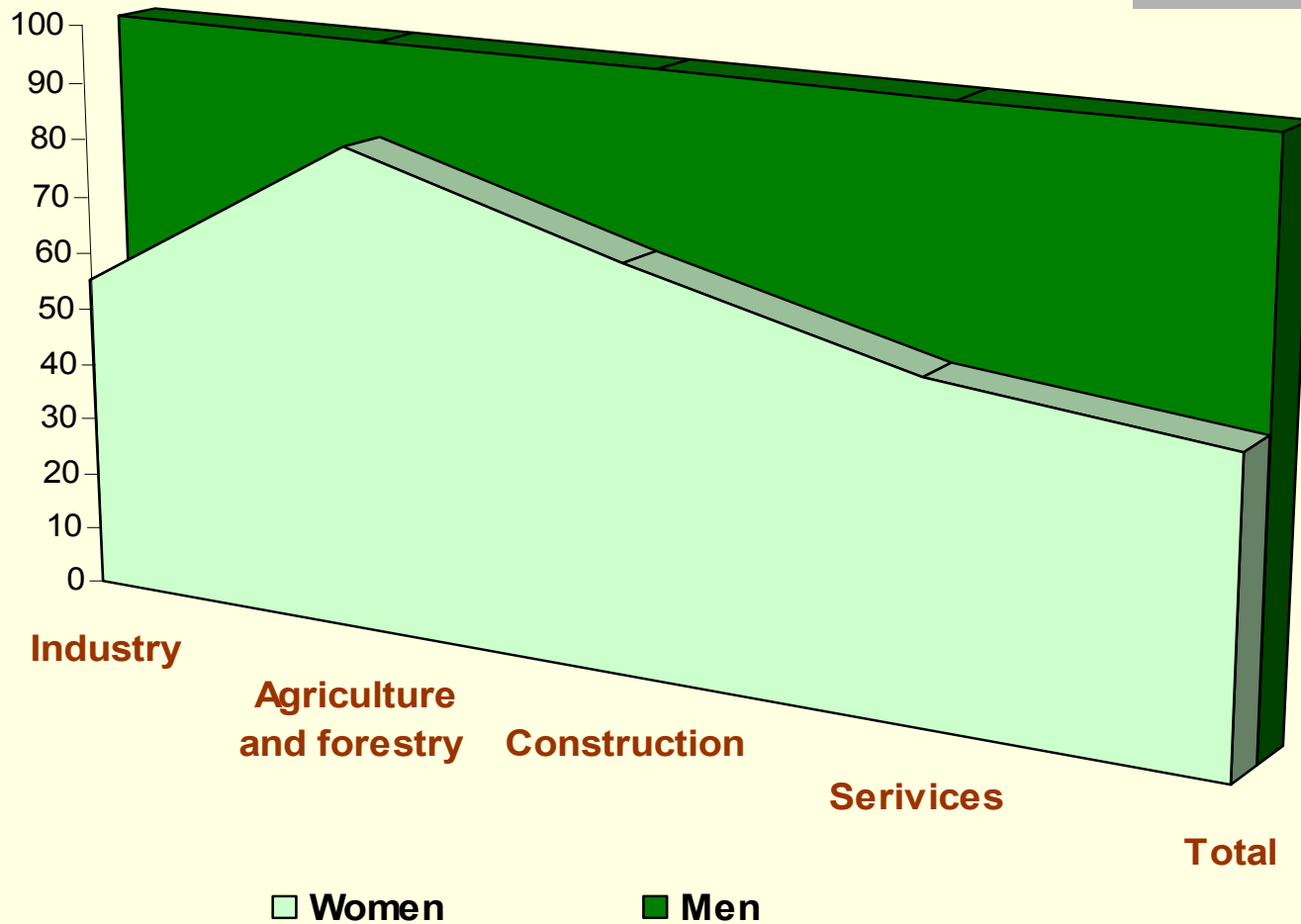
Paid and Unpaid work - two major differences (ArTUS)



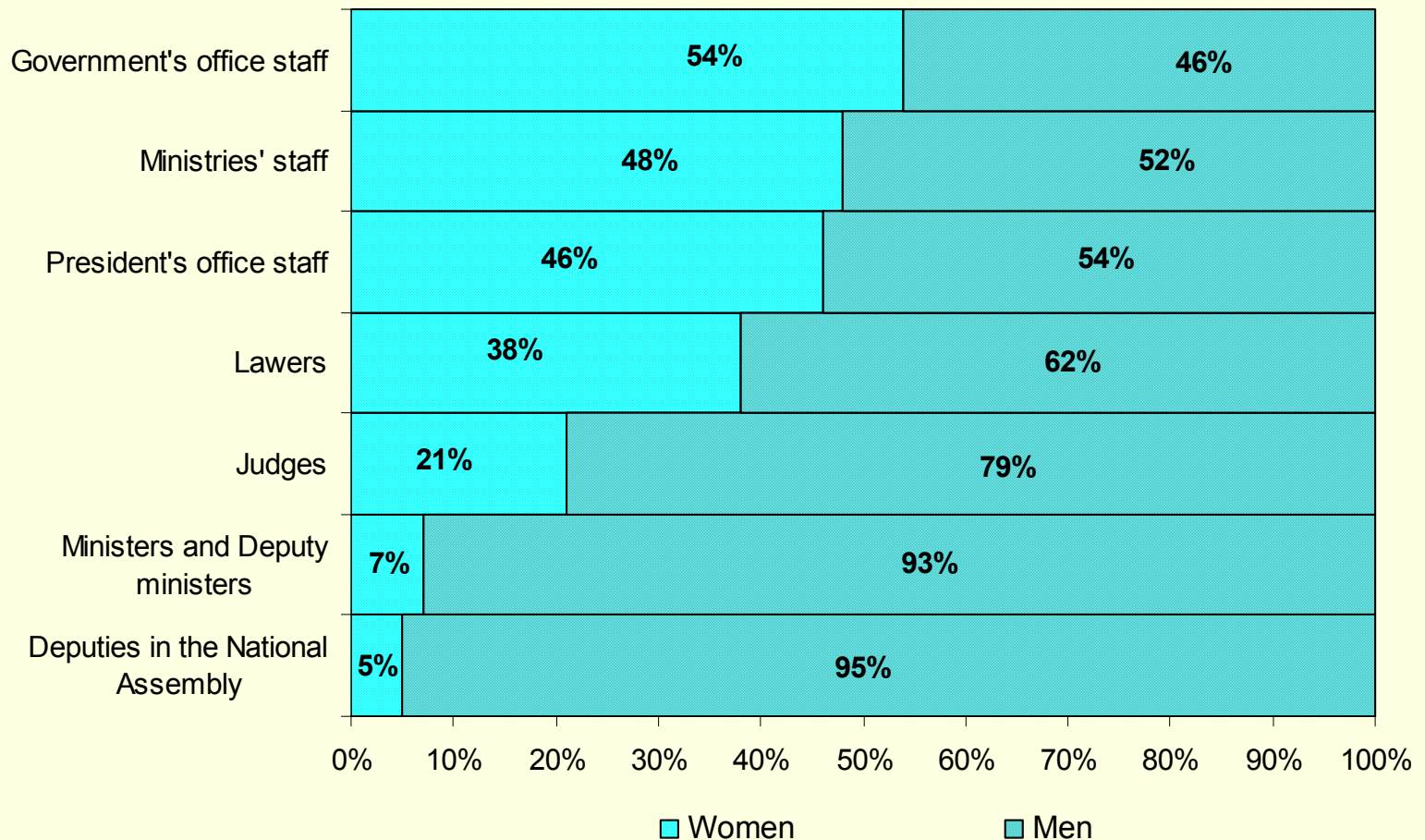
